Responsibilities:

Elite Tilt Panels:

Will provide and maintain as far as reasonably practical:

- safe systems of work;
- plant and substances in a safe condition;
- information, instruction, training, and supervision that is reasonably necessary to ensure that each worker is safe from injury and risks to health;
- a commitment to consult and co-operate with workers in all matters relating to health and safety in the workplace;
- a commitment to continually improve our performance through operational excellence and an effective safety management system.

Workers:

Each worker has an obligation to:

- comply with safe work practices, with the intent of avoiding injury to themselves and others and damage to plant and equipment;
- take reasonable care of the health and safety of themselves and others;
- wear personal protective equipment and clothing where necessary;
- comply with any direction given by management for health and safety;
- not misuse or interfere with anything provided for health and safety;
- report all accidents and incidents on the job immediately, no matter how trivial;
- report all known or observed hazards to the project foreman.
